

WOODEN SURFACES

GENERAL CARE

- Use coasters and trivets to prevent water and scorch marks.
- Keep out of direct sunlight. Rotate wooden furniture and table décor often to minimise the risk of sunburn.
- Maintain the humidity in the room as dry conditions may cause the wood to crack.
- Ensure that wooden legs have felt protectors to prevent colour transfer to carpets. Use protective felt/rubber feet under any wooden product to prevent colour transfer from the wood.

CLEANING

- Dust weekly.
- Wipe down wood surfaces using a barely damp micro-fiber cloth to remove any dirt and grime that may have built up.
- A mild dish liquid solution may be used for stubborn marks.
- Dry thoroughly.

GENERAL MAINTENANCE

- Check that the castors, legs and screws are tight.
- Oil the Ballbearing runners once a year.
- Check all hinges and locks are in working condition, contact us for any repair work.
- Check that all screws are tight that connects the wooden tops to the framework.

METAL / STEEL

RAW STEEL FINISH

- Wipe the metal top or legs with a damp microfibre cloth, warm water and a dash of gentle dish soap.
- Dip an old toothbrush into the soapy water to clean grooves and crevices, as well as any sticky spots.
- Wipe with a clean, damp cloth and dry with a lint-free cloth.

POWDER COAT / PAINT

- To clean, use mild soap, warm water, and a soft, clean cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals or a disinfectant that could break down the paint finish.
- Keep out of direct sunlight as the finish may fade.
